REQUIREMENTS FOR BOARDING

1. All animals must be current on all vaccinations.
2. All animals must be free of external parasites (ex. ticks, fleas, etc.), or they will be treated at owner's expense.
3. In the event my pet requires medical attention, I authorize the staff of Schertz Animal Hospital to proceed with reasonable procedures, and I agree to hold them harmless of outcome, and accept financial responsibility for those procedures deemed necessary.
4. We feed our canine guest Purina EN and our feline guest Pro Plan Chicken and Rice. If your pet requires a special diet, please bring it with you, along with feeding instructions.
5. Pets are admitted and discharged only during regular office hours. Pets may be picked up before 5:00pm to avoid an additional day's charge
6. There will be a charge of \$3.18 per day to administer and track medications. There will be no charge for administering heartworm prevention or vitamins.
7. Please understand that boarding may be stressful for some pets. Stress symptoms such as coughing, sneezing, sore throat, or diarrhea may occur. We seek to prevent such occurrences, but even with the best of care, these symptoms may develop. Please inform us if your pet has a previous history of "boarding illness".
8. We realize that pet toys, blankets, etc. may help your pet feel more comfortable during their stay, however Please do not bring any thing that might upset your pet if it should become lost or damaged. Also, please understand that soiled bedding may be in the laundry at the time of discharge.
9. There will be no after hours drop offs or pick ups available for your pet.
